Credit:

Students may register for graduate credit and the courses are three graduate credits each. Participants who **do not** wish to receive graduate credit may register for non-credit. Please note: Many school districts award “In-Service credits” or “PD hours” to employees who successfully complete these non-credit courses. A certificate of completion is awarded to all credit and non-credit students upon successful completion of the course requirements. Participants should **carefully** consider whether to register for the graduate credit section or if they would prefer to enroll as a non-credit student. Those students wishing to enroll in the graduate credit section must be admitted as a matriculated or non-matriculated Graduate student and are held to the published tuition fee schedule for all graduate students.

Tuition and Fees:

Graduate credit students: Tuition is \$1344 per graduate credit. The courses are three graduate credits each. Graduate credit students must also pay a \$133 University fee.

Non-credit students: A workshop fee is \$700 per course. The Orff-Schulwerk Teacher Education Levels courses are available for 60 Professional Development hours. The First Steps in Music, Conversational Solfege and First Steps with Orff Schulwerk courses are available for 45 Professional Development hours.

Reservations:

All students must pay a **non-refundable** reservation deposit of \$100 per course, which is deducted from the total course cost. Payment must be submitted to the Hofstra Department of Music via check. The payment will be applied towards your account. Non-credit participants may pay the \$700 registration cost in full, or pay the \$100 deposit. An invoice will be available to you online in your student portal and full detailed payment deadlines are available at hofstra.edu/academiccalendar. Payments may also be made in the Student Financial Services Suite, located in Memorial Hall, Room 206. If you must withdraw your registration, you must notify the Department of Music and Student Accounts, Memorial Hall Room 207.

Housing:
