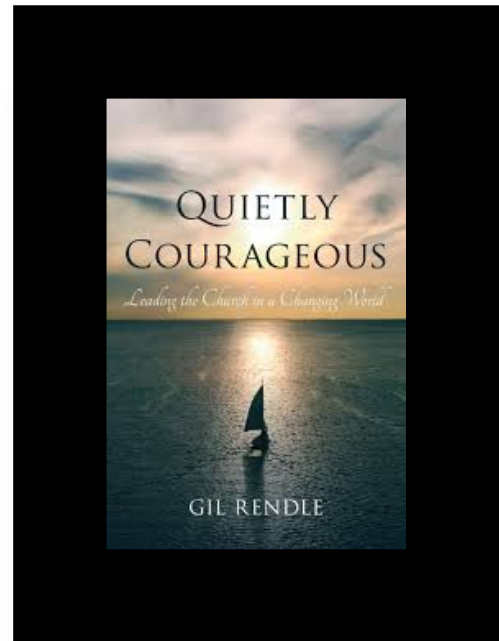


For Pastoral Leaders

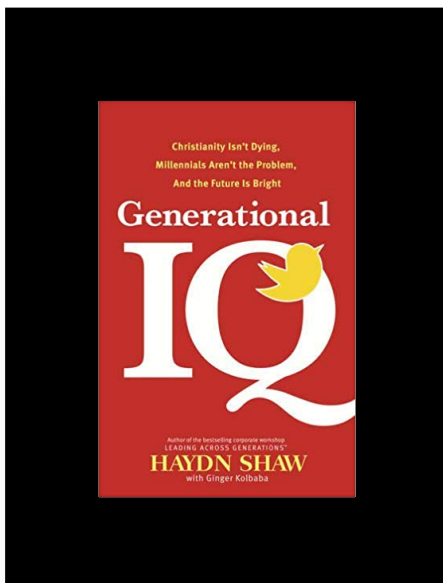
