Culture Clash is an account of her family’s experience as sponsors for Vietnamese refugees in the 1970’s,

The Activist’s Daughter, set in Chapel Hill, NC in 1963, explores a young woman’s coming to terms with her own values and acting on those values to fight racial prejudice.

Holiday Miracles A Christmas/Hanukkah Story, as you might expect, dealt with interfaith marriage.

On the much lighter side, **Over 50’s Single Night** is a humorous look at matching making among seniors in Temple Sisterhood.

Ellyn’s brush with fame occurred when her book **Safe Passage** was optioned by Steven Spielberg and ultimately made into a movie starring Susan Sarandon and Sam Sheppard.

As a full-time mother of four she pursued her writing career and established a local publishing company in the Carolinas to support local authors.

Ellyn grew up in the Washington, DC area and spent most of her adult life in the Carolinas. She currently lives in Greer, SC outside of Greenville, SC and remains the mother of four and grandmother of 15. And yes, she remembers all her grandchildren’s names.
