C4C UPDATE

I wanted to update you on our partnership with Eastlawn. As you may know, the food collected goes to our C4C (Congregations for Children) partner school Eastlawn Elementary. Historically, the food that we have collected has gone to Out of the Garden Project in Greensboro and then back to Burlington to our local elementary school. We are trying to simplify this process by collecting, sorting, and bagging food at Front Street. From here, the food can then be taken directly to Eastlawn and straight into the classrooms. This will provide many more opportunities for people at Front Street to participate in our Backpack Ministry by donating food or money, sorting, bagging, and distributing food. We can do this alongside one another. Watch this space for opportunities to get involved!

Thank you to everyone who donated food during our August food drive. We are so appreciative of your continued support of our Backpack Ministry. We are still in need of some specific additional items: canned meat, mac and cheese, pasta sauce and peanut butter in **plastic jars**, and granola bars. Also, if you find yourself with extra plastic bags from the grocery store, we would love them! We will use them to bag up the food for the students. You can drop the bags or food items in the Welcome Center. We will begin sending home food for 100 kids starting next week.

This year, I am excited to share that we can now go back into the school system to volunteer! We can serve as reading
