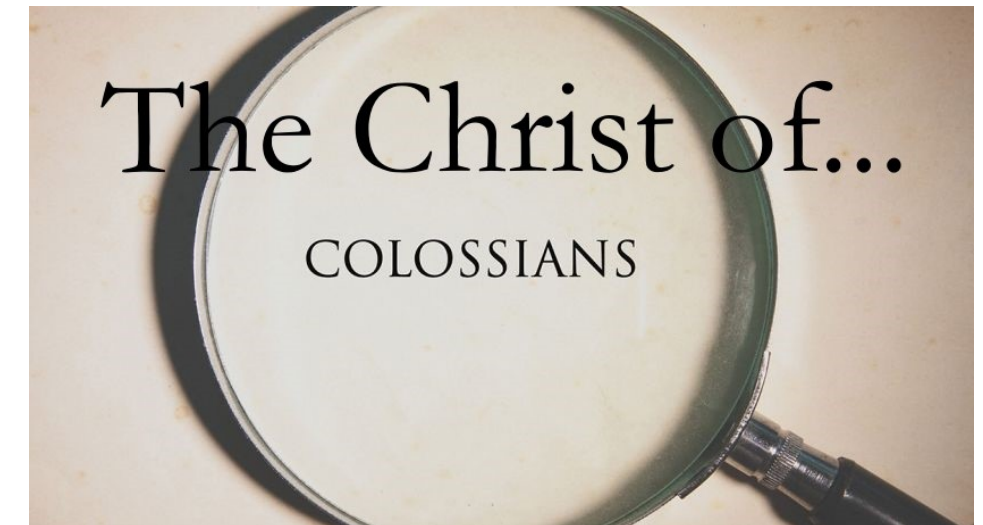
LIVE-STREAMING
