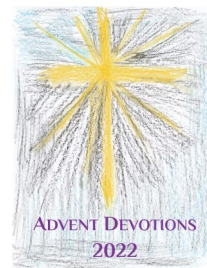
CHRIST OFFERING

CEREAL SUNDAY



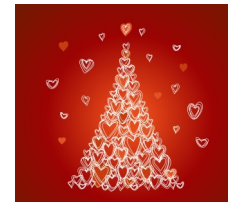
