I went through our statistics for the year and want to share with you because I am proud of these youth:

We held 30 youth events, whether those were trips, mission days, Breakfast Club or regular youth meetings and we had a total of 52 individual youth attend an event. We averaged 19 kids per week in the fall semester and 13 kids in the spring for an average of 16 for the year. We had 8 kids with more than 20 appearances and 22 kids with double figure appearances.

We donated \$1,000 in “Feed the Turtles” snack supper funds to Kaley Moser Evans’ and her Fellowship of Christian Athletes ministry. We packed over 15,000 meals with 55 of our closest friends and families during our Packathon. We assembled dozens of blessings bags for our homeless population. We collected hundreds of pounds of food for Lelia Wilson and Lauren Turner’s Williams Student Council food drive. We mowed grass, we washed busses, we spread mulch. We played Lazer X, went ziplining, skiing, and sunning at the beach. We had tremendous discussions about our faith, about the Bible, and experienced the Passion of the Christ during Lent.

Our youth are made up of kids mostly from Williams but what is great is that it is not strictly Front Street members. In fact, 23 of the 52 kids are not members of our church and of our “regular youth” half are non-members so we are showing them what Front Street offers. I am grateful for the opportunity and grateful for the kids who are bringing their friends. The more the merrier.
