TODAY’S MUSICAL MOMENT is being offered by Liam Forgey. Liam is a fifth grader at the Hawbridge School in Saxapahaw. He has been playing piano for three years, taking lessons from Janet Van Sant. When he is not practicing piano, he enjoys playing and watching basketball. Thank you for sharing your musical talents with your Front Street family, Liam.

WORSHIP NOTE: Healey Willan was an Anglo-Canadian organist and composer. He served as organist/choirmaster of St. Paul's Anglican Church, Bloor Street (Toronto's largest), the home of a magnificent new organ by Casavant Frères (though of decidedly English character) and then as Precentor at Toronto's Anglo-Catholic parish of Saint Mary Magdalene, where his cultivation of Gregorian chant and numerous compositions for choir made him world famous. Although his compositional output is prolific, he is perhaps best known for his sacred choral and organ works. The anthem “Arise, Shine, for Thy Light Is Come” showcases his love for Renaissance music. It includes three main sections organized around the two scripture passages. The outer sections feature the Isaiah text in a homophonic style, while the inner section features the Psalm text as a dialogue between the various voice parts. The Alleluias are set contrapuntally.
