

The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Canada Adventurous Journey Application

This bursary is funded by RBC Open for Gold, designed specifically to help Gold level participants complete their Gold Awards where the Adventurous Journey is a barrier to completion. Each bursary is approximately \$250 per participant. This application process is to help fund Adventurous Journeys taking place in 2019. Applications must be submitted by the Division to the National Office. Additional bursary applications, if meeting all criteria, will be put on waitlist for first come first serve, and can be applied to adventurous journeys retroactively that took place earlier in 2019.

Criteria:

- Applications are for individual applicants, not award units as a whole
- Applications must be sent in by the Division Office
- These funds should help young people from the following communities: General population, women, visible minorities, persons with disabilities, underserved populations, indigenous, LGTB+, newcomers, low socio-economic status, rural and remote individuals.
- Only 12 participants from each Division will be approved, additional applications from the Division will be put on a waitlist. If not all reserved Divisional bursaries are determined within the first 2 months, it will open up to those from other Divisions on the waitlist.
- If applicants require more than \$250, we can discuss on a case-by-case basis
