

Are You Worth the Price?
1 Corinthians 6:19-20

Daniel 5:27—*you have been weighed in the balance and found deficient.*

1 Peter 1:18-19—*knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.*

1 Peter 2:22—*He [Jesus] did not commit sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth.*

2 Corinthians 5:21—*He [God] made the one who did not know sin to be sin for us, so that in Him [Jesus] we might become the righteousness of God.*

Questions requiring a decision...

- If you have never repented of your sins and placed your faith in Jesus Christ as ruler of your life, is there any good reason why you would not willingly do that now?
- As a Christian is there anything in your life that doesn't measure up to the price God paid for your redemption? Will you confess that sin/short coming, repent, and live in God's forgiveness and power?
