THE BALLAD OF WALLIS ISLAND

99 mins | Rated PG 13 | Comedy

We follow Charles (Tim Key), an eccentric lottery winner who lives alone on a remote island and dreams of getting his favorite musicians, McGwyer Mortimer (Tom Basden & Carey Mulligan) back together. His fantasy turns into reality when the bandmates and former lovers accept his invitation to play a private show at his home on Wallis Island. Old tensions resurface as Charles tries desperately to salvage his dream gig.

HOW TO TRAIN YOUR DRAGON

125 mins | Rated PG 13 | Animation **Advance Tickets**

From three-time Oscar® nominee and Golden Globe winner Dean DeBlois, comes a stunning live-action reimagining of the film that launched the beloved franchise. On the rugged isle of Berk, where Vikings and dragons have been bitter enemies for generations, Hiccup stands apart. The inventive yet overlooked son of Chief Stoick the Vast, Hiccup defies centuries of tradition when he befriends Toothless, a feared Night Fury dragon. Their unlikely bond reveals the true nature of dragons, challenging the very foundations of Viking society.

JANE AUSTIN WRECKED MY LIFE

This charming film follows Agathe (Rutherford) a hopelessly clumsy yet charming young woman who works in the legendary Shakespeare & Co. bookshop in Paris. While she dreams of being a successful writer, and of experiencing love akin to a Jane Austen novel, she finds herself desperately single and plagued by writer's block. When Agathe's best friend (Pauly) gets her invited to the Jane Austen Writers' Residency in England, she finally has her Jane Austen moment... and is caught in a very unexpected romantic triangle.

LILLY

Based on the life of Lilly Ledbetter, this emotional drama follows a courageous factory worker who fights for justice when cheated and mistreated by her company. LILLY stars Golden Globe winner / Academy Award nominee, Patricia Clarkson, who brings a blend of strength, quiet dignity, and emotional depth to the role, making her performance truly captivating.

SACRAMENTO

89 mins | Rated R | Comedy

Following the death of his father, energetic and free-spirited Rickey (Michael Angarano) convinces long-time friend Glenn (Michael Cera) to go on an impromptu road trip from Los Angeles to Sacramento. In the worn yellow seats of Glenn's old college convertible, the two men confront their anxiety-ridden lives, addressing past mistakes and questioning what their futures hold.



SINNERS #1 Movie in America

Ryan Coogler's gory and glorious 'Sinners,' a Southern vampire horror-musical, is not merely a great movie but an eternal movie, one that will transcend today's box office and tomorrow's awards to live on as a forever favorite. "Sinners" is set in 1932 Mississippi where a preacher's teenage son, Sammie (Miles Caton), is risking his soul to sing with a guitar. His dad (Saul Williams) deems it a sin. "You keep dancing with the devil, one day he's going to follow you home," his father cautions a few minutes into the film. From the opening scene, a flash-forward to Sammie stumbling into church, bloody and half-catatonic, we already know he's right.


