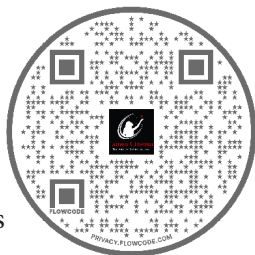

### ROBERT ZEMECKIS: Movie Magician

Robert Zemeckis is celebrated for his pioneering use of CGI (computer-generated imagery), which he used to create groundbreaking visual effects in films like Who Framed Roger Rabbit and Forrest Gump. His work, including the Back to the Future trilogy, demonstrates an ability to blend technological innovation with strong storytelling, influencing a generation of filmmakers to push creative boundaries and use new tools to create more engaging experiences.

Marty McFly, a 17-year-old high school student, is accidentally sent 30 years into the past in a time-traveling DeLorean invented by his close friend, the maverick scientist Doc Brown.
