When a modern family is forced to relocate to the remote English countryside, the children discover a magical tree inhabited by extraordinary and eccentric residents. At the top of the tree, they are transported to spectacular, fantastical lands, where the wonders and trials of their adventures help the family reconnect and rediscover one another for the first time in years.



THE LAST PICTURE SHOWS

81 mins | Rated PG | Documentary

Filmmaker Rustin Thompson journeys into the American West on a search for traces of what was once a center of small-town life: the movie theater. Rustin poetically intersperses excerpts from Peter Bogdanovich's 1971 classic film *The Last Picture Show*, as well as reflections on past and present hardships facing the film exhibition industry. *The Last Picture Shows* is not only a timely portrait of an industry in crisis, one facing the headwinds of consolidation, streaming, and the diminishing theatrical experience, but it also reminds viewers that even in vast cinema deserts, there are oases of community and gathering that remain, where the movie house continues to be a place of wonder, contemplation, and connection.

106 mins | Rated R | Drama

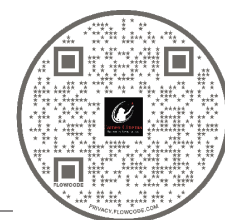
