THE FANTASTIC FOUR: FIRST STEPS

115mins | Rated PG-13 | Adventure, Action

Set against the backdrop of a 1960s-inspired, retro-futuristic world, "The Fantastic Four: First Steps" introduces Marvel's First Family—Reed Richards/Mister Fantastic (Pedro Pascal), Sue Storm/Invisible Woman (Vanessa Kirby), Johnny Storm/Human Torch (Joseph Quinn) and Ben Grimm/The Thing (Ebon Moss-Bachrach) as they face their most daunting challenge yet.

THE LAST CLASS

71 mins | Rated PG-13 | Documentary

The Last Class is a nuanced and deeply personal portrait of master educator Robert Reich teaching his final course and reflecting on a period of immense transformation, personally and globally. It is a love letter to education. The former Secretary of Labor might be famous for his public service, best-selling books, and viral social media posts, but he always considered teaching his true calling.

THE ROSES

125 mins | Rated R | Drama

Life seems easy for picture-perfect couple Ivy (Colman) and Theo (Cumberbatch): successful careers, great kids, an enviable sex life. But underneath the façade of the perfect family is a tinderbox of competition and resentments that's ignited when Theo's professional dreams come crashing down.

SHARI & LAMBCHOP

92 mins | Rated PG-13 | Documentary

Shari Lewis was a dancer, singer, and magician but is best known as the ventriloquist behind sock puppets Charlie Horse, Hush Puppy and, of course, Lamb Chop. This lively doc charts the life, loves, and career hits and misses of this spunky perfectionist, who forever changed the face of children's television.

F1: THE MOVIE Return Engagement

156mins | Rated PG-13 | Drama (Extended runtime) Dubbed "the greatest that never was," Sonny Hayes (Brad Pitt) was FORMULA 1's most promising phenom of the 1990s until an accident on the track nearly ended his career. Thirty years later, his former teammate Ruben Cervantes (Javier Bardem), convinces Sonny to come back to FORMULA 1 for one last shot at saving the team and being the best in the world.

92 mins | Rated PG | Adventure, Action, Comedy When a young girl's sketchbook falls into a strange pond, her drawings come to life-unpredictable, chaotic, and dangerously real. As the town unravels, she and her brother must track down the creatures before they leave permanent damage. 
