Roger Corman's 1960 cult classic, **Little Shop of Horrors** will be accompanied by a live performance of its iconic score featuring the **Grand Feature Film Orchestra**. The orchestra is a San Francisco Bay area nonprofit that performs original restored film scores live, synchronizing the performance with the on-screen action.

The film tells the story of a Skid Row flower shop that becomes famous when the shop's schmuck of a delivery boy, Seymour, breeds a colossal new strain of plant nicknamed "Audrey Jr." Fans love Jack Nicholson's first feature film appearance in the tiny but unforgettable role of the masochistic dental patient, Wilbur Force. 
