7-16 86th Annual Sturgis Motorcycle Rally: The [86th Sturgis Motorcycle Rally](#) is themed "Sturgis Salutes America!" to commemorate the country's 250th birthday and will include numerous events, such as concerts, charity rides, and races.

28-30 11th Annual Fall River Hot Air Balloon Festival: This event is the Chamber's signature event and is the largest annual event that the Chamber organizes. With the support of Sponsors, City Government, Members and the Community, the Chamber brings Hot Air Balloons to Hot Springs each August. The festival begins Friday at noon, with a Vendor Fair in Centennial Park, which continues until Saturday afternoon. Balloons launch early Saturday & Sunday mornings of the festival, then Saturday evening there is a Night Glow in Centennial Park (weather permitting for all events). Currently, an estimated 5,000 people attend the festival throughout the weekend.

Every year participants meet at the foot of the Battle Mountain Grand Staircase, in downtown Hot Springs, to climb the 141-step staircase with neighbors and friends, old & new. Although sign in begins at 6:00am and climbing starts at 6:46am, climbers may arrive any time after that. The Challenge Director stays until 6:46pm or the last climber is done, whichever comes first.
