

Healthy Practices Administrator Certificate (HPAC) 2023-2024 Overview and Course Schedule

Healthy Practices Administrator Certificate (HPAC) is an opportunity to help early child care center directors/administrators support improving quality nutrition and increasing physical activity for children. HPAC consists of four components: Components 1 & 3 can be stand-alone PDR credit training hours. Components 2 & 4 can only be taken if components 1 & 3 are completed. Participants who complete all four components will receive the Healthy Practices Administrator Certificate worth 33 PDR training credit hours; as well as materials that will assist them in supporting physical activity and healthy nutrition for their individual program. HPAC participants must complete the registration form to identify the component areas in which they plan to complete. HPAC is offered by Arkansas State University Childhood Services.

Healthy Practices Administrator Certificate (HPAC) Component 1: Preventing Obesity in Early Childhood is the first course that is required in order to obtain the HPAC Credential. Preventing Obesity in Early Childhood is worth 5 hours of PDR training credit. The course takes **3 weeks** to complete. It can be taken as a stand-alone course or part of the HPAC Credential.
