

Health Insurance Open Enrollment Begins in PA



What is open enrollment?

This is the yearly period when you can buy health insurance. If you don't enroll during this time, you won't be able to sign up until the next one, except in limited instances called special enrollment periods. Pennie's Open Enrollment Period runs yearly from **November 1st to January 15th**. During this window, you can secure 2023 coverage with a January 1st or February 1st effective date.

Apply for coverage

Pay your first month's premium

- Photo ID(s) (driver's license, passport or other option proving your identity)
