Our upcoming Computer Science opportunities are as follows:

Application Developer Intern- International Headquarters: Collaborate with a team of developers and designers to design, develop, test and support new features. Will contribute to the documentation of API's and applications, also assisting in translating UX/ UI specifications and wire frames to both web and mobile devices, as well as the development.

IT Enterprise Systems Intern- International Headquarters: Assist and document requirements for new IT systems. Test custom software applications and report and track system defects found during testing. Additionally, will build new reports in support of various ministry areas using Tableau, Excel, and other reporting tools.

Business Systems Intern- International Headquarters: Involved in the planning, analysis, and implementation associated with the Human Resource Management System and application. The Systems Analyst serves as a technical point-of-contact for assigned functional requirements and process into a software and process solution and a working knowledge of a System/ Software Development Life Cycle.

Service Desk Analyst Intern- International Headquarters: Responsible for computer builds, upgrades, and repairs. Works in collaboration with the Service Desk team to provide equipment to end-users in an efficient and timely manner, troubleshooting PC and Mac software and hardware issues.

Donor Systems Analyst Intern- International Headquarters: Initiate CRM projects by planning, scoping, and analyzing to create a successful system design. Work with business users to refine project scope to accurately reflect desired system usage as well as create an effective system design that matches the IT department's expectations and create documentation to ensure proper testing is in place.

Network Admin Intern- International Headquarters: Work with Junior and Senior Network Admins to build documentation libraries, basic system administration, verify configurations, automate appropriate tasks, and organize projects.
