

30 DAYS OF PRAYER



The United Pentecostal Church International has chosen the theme **MAKE HIM KNOWN** as we proclaim, “Jesus is the answer for the world today!” In this case, *Known* is used to refer to someone who is clearly recognized, familiar to, or understood by all people.

Let us embrace the creed, “To know Christ and to make Him known.” The Word of God declares, “I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD” (Ezekiel 38:23). “Never be afraid to trust an unknown future to a known God.” (Corrie Ten Boom)

Join with us in prayer and fasting, and “make Him known,” proclaiming that, “Above Him there’s no other, Jesus is the way!”

WEEK ONE

Pray that we exemplify a lifestyle of repentance, obedience, and sacrifice unto God in a way that we would make Him known to this world. *“And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God...let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel...”* (1 Kings 18:36).

WEEK TWO

Pray that we call upon, advocate, and demonstrate in the name of Jesus, and serve Him with gratitude. Pray that we spread the gospel and make Him and His deeds known, even in the midst of economic, social, and moral degradation, societal perils, political unrest, pandemics, world crises, etc. *“Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people”* (1 Chronicles 16:8).

WEEK THREE

Pray that God would heal our land; do miracles, signs and wonders; bring divine healing upon the earth; and that He and His ways would be made known. *“That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations”* (Psalm 67:2).

WEEK FOUR

Pray that we do the will of God and that He would bring great success to every ministry, church, and work in His kingdom, and use the full operation of the fivefold ministry so that He and His mighty power be known. *“Nevertheless he saved them for his name’s sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known”* (Psalm 106:8).

WEEK FIVE

Pray for the seven main centers of power: government, church, education, media, family, business, and military. Pray that God would bring great salvation, deliverance, revival, and harvest, including the restoration of prodigals to the Church. *“And the LORD shall be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians shall know the LORD in that day...”* (Isaiah 19:21).
