Therefore:

In Principle We Must:

“This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh” (Galatians 5:16).

“But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law” (Galatians 5:18).

“If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit” (Galatians 5:25).

Whatever is obtainable from God sometimes come through spiritual warfare prayer (Luke 1:37).

Pray:

- that we linger until the Spirit begins to intercede for us with groanings too deep for words (Romans 8:26).
- that we will build ourselves on our most holy faith, praying in the Spirit (Jude 1:20).
- that we will move from a word of prayer, a moment of prayer, a minute of prayer, and enter into seasons of prayer (Romans 12:12).
- that we will commune with God without ceasing... an attitude of prayer and God-consciousness (I Thessalonians 5:17; Psalm 109:4).
- that we will live righteously and pray fervently (James 5:16; Colossians 4:12).
- that we will set our mind on higher things, and not on things around us (Colossians 3:2).
