How to Use the "Build a Shoebox" Feature

- 1) Navigate on your web browser to:

- 2) From that page, choose "Start Building" or "Build It For Me."




The "Start Building" Option

1. Choose "Girl" or "Boy" on the next screen.



2. Choose the age range on the next screen.




3. On the next page, you get to pick the item types. Have fun! The screen will tell you how many of each category to pick. If you change your mind, click the grayed out item again and the system will remove it.

4. To see all the items, use the arrow in the green bar on the side of the screen.



5. When you have filled the box, the system will give you the option to go to the "next" step or "adjust shoebox."



6. You can then type a message to the child and add a photo, if you would like. Click "Next."

7. Finally, scroll down to "Checkout" and follow the instructions to complete the process!

The "Build It For Me" Option

1. Very simple! When you click this option, it adds a box to the cart. You can adjust the number of boxes, if you would like to do more than one.
2. You can also add a "Start Building" by clicking the "Build Another" button.



3. When you are done adding boxes, scroll down to the "Checkout" and follow the instructions to complete the process.
