All Saints Day * November 1, 2020

Sermon by the Reverend Tom Rutherford

Revelation 7:9-17 * Psalm 34 * 1 John 3:1-3 * Matthew 5:1-12

ALL Saints

"Saint" = "set apart BY and FOR God"

See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called the children of God! And that is what we are! 1 John 3:1

Our assignment is not to work for God to BECOME saints;

it's to cooperate with God because we ARE saints.

In Matthew 5:3-10, Jesus says:

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied.

Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God.

Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Chewing on Our Daily Bread

Questions for conversation with your family, Home Group, or a friend

1. Who is a "saintly" person you know? What makes him or her "saintly?"
2. 1 John 3:1 says, "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called the children of God! And that is what we are!" What does it mean to you to be a "child of God?" And how does that affect or influence your life?
3. The word "saint" means to be "set apart BY and FOR God," which means we're "saints" because God "sets us apart;" NOT because of what we've done. What quality, attitude, or behavior in your life is evidence that God is at work in you "setting you apart" for himself?
4. Our assignment as God's children is not to work for God to BECOME saints; it's to cooperate with God because we ARE saints. What is one way you are cooperating with God to become more saintly?
5. PRAY:
 - ✦ Thanking God for that saint you mentioned in #1 above.
 - ✦ Thanking God for making you his child, setting you apart for himself, and making you a saint.
 - ✦ For grace to cooperate with God to become more saintly.
 - ✦ For any needs in your group.

How to Use the "Build a Shoebox" Feature

- 1) Navigate on your web browser to:
www.samaritanspurse.org/operation-christmas-child/buildonline/
- 2) From that page, choose "Start Building" or "Build It For Me."



The "Start Building" Option

1. Choose "Girl" or "Boy" on the next screen.



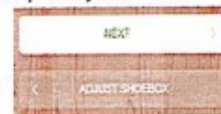
2. Choose the age range on the next screen.



3. On the next page, you get to pick the item types. Have fun! The screen will tell you how many of each category to pick. If you change your mind, click the grayed out item again and the system will remove it.

4. To see all the items, use the arrow in the green bar on the side of the screen.

5. When you have filled the box, the system will give you the option to go to the "next" step or "adjust shoebox."



6. You can then type a message to the child and add a photo, if you would like. Click "Next."

7. Finally, scroll down to "Checkout" and follow the instructions to complete the process!

The "Build It For Me" Option

1. Very simple! When you click this option, it adds a box to the cart. You can adjust the number of boxes, if you would like to do more than one.
2. You can also add a "Start Building" by clicking the "Build Another" button.



3. When you are done adding boxes, scroll down to the "Checkout" and follow the instructions to complete the process.
