The course represents a unique combination of engagement with the artistic treasures of Florence and classroom sessions focused on enhancing one's capacity for differentiated leadership, as seen through the lens of family systems theory.

- In-class input to challenge students to reflect on how they can function at their best as leaders and not allow organizational anxiety to distract them from their mission.
- Interspersed with classroom sessions will be visits to the major artistic monuments of Florence to reflect on the intersection of art and the development of the self, as embodied in the evolving role of the Renaissance artist.
- On-site lectures: Orsanmichele, the Baptistry and Cathedral, Museo dell'Opera del Duomo, Museo del Bargello, Church of Santa Croce, Galleria degli Uffizi, Church of Santa Trinitá, Galleria dell'Accademia, Museo di San Marco, and more.
- Engagement with the sculpture of Ghiberti, Donatello, Verrocchio, Michelangelo, as well as the painting of Giotto, Fra Angelico, Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, Leonardo da Vinci, Raphael, etc. — and how their art reflects aspects of differentiation of self.
- Join us for an enriching week of learning that provides all participants with a renewed sense of commitment to their vocation as a leader.
