More information will be announced about each event as it gets closer, so please pay attention to event specific information as it is sent out. We look forward to seeing you at our next event!










FEBRUARY 2020 NEWSLETTER FEBRUARY EDUCATIONAL LUNCHEON

Introduction

To bring you this information, we go directly to the County Clerk's offices in the relevant county seats for all of the mid-continent's hottest plays and get a first-hand report on the activity and number of landmen in the courthouse from the preceding week. 
