TOS New Zealand Report for Year End 30 September 2019

The TOS in New Zealand is doing very well and the majority of TS branches around New Zealand do some form of TOS activity; either sponsoring a child and/or supporting various projects and raising funds either locally or nationally. The key aspect here is *service in action*, with people working together towards a common goal.

We continue to have strong support from the Section in NZ and high visibility in the National Section's magazine *TheoSophia*. A special thank you to the National President John Vorstermans, who understands the value and contribution of TOS work in supporting The Society's objects and role of action on the spiritual path.
