Basic Tools for ALL Classes:

- Highlighters
- Post-It notes
- Pens & Pencils (the amount of these we go through in a year is staggering, please make sure your student has something to write with everyday)
 - Manual, hand held pencil sharpener if your student uses regular pencils ([example](#))
 - Mechanical pencil lead refills if your student uses mechanical pencils ([example](#))
- Pencil/Pen Case ([example](#))
- Loose Leaf Paper ([example 1](#) , [example 2](#))
- Folders (either 1 for each subject or a [multi-pocket folder](#) / [accordion file organizer](#))

Optional, but recommended:

- A planner or scheduling notebook ([example](#))
- Wired (not bluetooth) headphones (for use with school computers - we have class sets, but students may prefer to use their own)
- File Box (to be kept at home) for organizing/storing papers/materials that no longer need to be carried to school everyday but may be useful in the future ([example](#))
- Hanging File Folders ([example](#)) for File Box (to be stored at home)
- Access to computer at home
- We also welcome donations of tissues, paper towels & hand sanitizer for all classes 😊

10th Grade:

Basic Tools for ALL Classes:

- Highlighters
- Pens, pencils, erasers (**make sure you have something to write with every day**)
- Pencil case
- Notebook: Spiral or 3-ring binder with loose leaf, with a section for *each* class
- Folder(s): With a pocket for *each* class OR an accordion folder for all classes

For math: loose-leaf and graph paper

- Calculator: Calculators are available for use in the science and math (TI-84 Plus CE) classrooms, but they cannot be taken home. Free online options are available.

- Graphing calculator: Calculators (TI-84 Plus CE) are available for use in science and math classrooms, but they cannot be taken home. Free online options are available.

12th Grade:

Basic Tools for ALL Classes:

- Highlighters
- Pens, pencils, erasers (make sure you have something to write with every day)
- Folder(s): With a pocket for *each* class OR an accordion folder for all classes
- Notebook: Spiral or 3-ring binder with loose leaf, with a section for *each* class except math

Optional, but recommended:

- Post-It notes
- At home system for keeping materials that no longer need to be carried to school everyday but may be useful in the future

For math class:

- A composition notebook - Graph ruled is preferred, college ruled is acceptable, but it must be a composition notebook (not spiral bound or looseleaf)
- Calculus students will need a separate “messy” notebook later in the year, but it is not required at the beginning of the year.
