



PROTOCOL FOR USE OF MANDEVILLE CANYON ASSOCIATION CAMERAS

1. Report crime to the police.
2. A detective supervisor will review your case to determine if there are any leads (witness or video at your house with pictures and time, etc) to warrant follow-up. Detectives are not assigned to every case based on the lack of leads; therefore, a detective may not contact you. That is why having your own video cameras is so important. It is proven that criminals are less likely to burglarize your house if you have visible cameras. Although Maria Gray is our LAPD community liaison, she is not involved in this process.
3. If there is enough of a lead, the detective will contact Palisades Patrol directly and arrange to receive the data from the security cameras to review. There is no reason for you to attempt to contact Palisades Patrol.
4. If there are costs to cover processing the data requested by LAPD, Palisades Patrol will contact you directly for payment.
