SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: Up to \$1500.00 to be applied to the 2023 Region 4 REALTORS® Conference & Expo registration, hotel, and miscellaneous expenses

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Albemarle Area Association of REALTORS® Leadership Scholarship is to provide assistance to qualified applicants based on their leadership potential.

ELIGIBILITY: Any primary REALTOR® member in good standing with AAAR and interested in serving on the Board of Directors or Committees of AAAR is eligible to apply for the scholarship. Individuals may only receive the scholarship once. Recipients will be expected to attend education sessions and various NC REALTORS® committee meetings while attending Convention. Recipients will be required to make a short presentation, either in-person or written, to the Board of Directors after Convention to discuss their experience.

AAAR will determine scholarship recipients on a points basis. Points may be earned by:

- Attendance at AAAR Workshops (1 point per workshop)
- Attendance at AAAR General Membership Luncheons (1 point per luncheon)
- Participation in AAAR Volunteer Opportunities (1 point per event)
- Current Board of Directors or Committee Participation (3 points)
- RPAC Investor (3 points)
- Submitting Requested Essay, not to exceed 500 words (up to 10 points, will be judged by scholarship committee)

PLEASE NOTE: Recipients will be expected to volunteer to serve AAAR in a leadership capacity in 2024 or may be required to reimburse the scholarship fund.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

DESCRIPTION: The Albemarle Area Association of REALTORS® (AAAR) may provide up to three \$1500 scholarships to three primary AAAR members (in good standing) to attend the 2023 Region 4 REALTORS® Conference and Expo.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the AAAR Leadership Scholarship is to provide assistance to qualified applicants based on their leadership potential.

POLICY:

- 1. The 2023 Region 4 REALTORS® Conference and Expo is scheduled for October 16-19, 2023, at the Savannah International Trade & Convention Center in Savannah, GA.
- 2. All AAAR primary members in good standing with the association are eligible to apply for one of three scholarships.
- 3. AAAR will pay for each recipient's convention registration as well as hotel and miscellaneous expenses up to a total of \$1500.00 (AAAR will reimburse the member OR will pay expenses for member as requested).
- 4. All applications received will be reviewed by a Scholarship Committee appointed by the President and approved by the Board of Directors.
- 5. Applications are due to the AAAR office by June 30, 2023. Winners of the Scholarship will be announced by July 31, 2023.
- 6. Winners of the Scholarships will be chosen on a points basis (as per the application). However, AAAR reserves the right not to award the scholarships if scholarship requirements are not met.
- 7. Winners will be expected to attend education sessions as well as NCR committee meetings while at convention, accompanied by President, President-Elect, or AE.
