JOIN A MEETING

Pre-requisites:

- Each meeting has a unique 9, 10, or 11-digit number called a meeting ID that will be required to join a Zoom meeting.
- If you are joining via telephone, you will need the teleconferencing number provided in the meeting invite.

Open your web browser (E.g., Google Chrome, Safari, Microsoft Edge or Internet Explorer)

1. Go to zoom.us/join
2. Follow the directions and prompts to download the Zoom Application
3. You will be prompted to automatically join your Zoom meeting with the unique URL you were provided

If the Zoom Application does not download, you can join with your web browser:

1. Go to zoom.us/join
2. Enter your Meeting ID provided by the host/organizer
3. Click Join

HOW TO APPLY A BACKGROUND

The feature is simple to use and can protect your privacy. With the camera on your handset or computer, you can apply the built-in background features provided by zoom, or upload an image of your choice.

Pre-requisite:

- In order to apply the background feature, you must download/install the Zoom application on your computer or device and register for a free account

To Enable the Virtual Background as a Zoom User:

1. Make sure you have followed the pre-requisites steps identified above
2. Sign in to your Zoom account
3. Navigate to **"Settings"** then **"In Meeting (Advanced)"**
4. Click the button to enable the Virtual Background

Allow another user to take control of your camera during a meeting

Virtual background

Allow users to replace their background with any selected image. Choose or upload an image in the Zoom Desktop application settings.



To Use a Virtual Background:

After you have signed in to your Zoom account and enabled the virtual background feature, follow the steps below.

1. Click your profile picture or initials in the upper right-hand corner
2. Click settings
3. Select Virtual Background
4. Choose an image provided by Zoom or upload your own
