APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS

The recipient of the Ebell Club of Fullerton High School Scholarship:

1. Must be a graduating senior in the class of 2026 who plans to continue their education or training after graduation We welcome students applying to trade schools as well as those applying to college, university, and certificate programs.
2. Must be graduating from an FJUHSD school: Buena Park HS, Fullerton Union HS, La Habra HS, La Vista HS or La Sierra HS, Sonora HS, Sunny Hills HS, Troy HS.
3. Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.
4. Must be able to demonstrate involvement in creating community.

HOW TO APPLY

Seniors interested in applying for the Ebell Club of Fullerton High School Scholarship Award should complete the following list:

1. Attach the completed application sheet including the Students Name and ID number.
2. Submit an essay of no more than 500 words describing why the student thinks they deserve the award.
3. Attach a copy of the students high school transcripts containing the overall high school GPA.
4. Ask a teacher or other leader to write a recommendation letter that speaks to the applicant's involvement in creating community.
5. Watch for an email and respond within 3 days to schedule an interview appointment.
