The Foster Parent Champion Program (FPC) is looking for experienced caregivers who have a desire to partner with DFS, other caregivers and the community.

Ideal candidates will be licensed caregivers who can assist others navigate the foster care system. They will have a general knowledge of resources in Clark County and are willing to attend Child and Family Team (CFT) and other similar meetings. A positive attitude and good communication skills are a must. Additionally, applicants must have a strong desire to build the Foster Parent Champion Program and help children and families along the way.

This position is 20 hours a week, with some evening and weekend hours. Flexible scheduling may be available. Bilingual candidates are encouraged to apply. Basic computer knowledge is required.



Foster Parent Champion General Tasks May Include

- Answer shared phone line, Monday – Friday, 9 am – 7 pm, providing support to callers
- Initiate phone calls to licensed and unlicensed caregivers, DFS Specialists, Licensing Representatives and other workers
- Provide support and information to caregivers including free and low-cost community resources
- Conduct research to identify and determine appropriateness of resources in meeting the needs of caregivers; maintain information in shared workspace
- Communicate with DFS Specialists regarding additional referrals needed for caregivers
- Attend CFTs/TDMs or other caregiver meetings, assisting the caregiver as needed
- Assist caregivers in obtaining resources from community partners
- Maintain documentation of contact with caregivers
- Review monthly additions to QPI Just in Time Trainings
- Participate in unit and resource meetings
- Maintain current calendar status of activities and appointments
- Present information to DFS staff, caregiver support groups and community partners regarding the FPC Program
- Attend community events to promote FPC program and provide information to caregivers
- Represent DFS in a positive manner
