- Play exploration games while learning about the animals and the environment
- Did we mention you can pet a shark?

SeaQuest Las Vegas recently added a Tegu lizard, one of the largest species of lizard in the world. Another of the favorite animals at the Aquarium is Einstein,

a giant sulcata tortoise that roams the entire property at will.

"Einstein is on the loose!" says Stewart.

## **Ever Taken a Selfie with a Mermaid?**

Now's your chance. SeaQuest Las Vegas's resident mermaids swim about in the various aquariums.

"They swim right up to the wall of the tank," says Stewart. "You can take a selfie with them."

Unlike other local aquariums, SeaQuest Las Vegas is a true, immersion experience. Feeling like swimming with stingrays and tropical fish? For an additional fee, guests can take a dip and swim among the aquatic life.

Staff members are enthusiastic and ready to share their love of the animals and their worlds. "You can grab just about any one of our guest services staff and they'll talk to you about the exhibits and teach you about the animals," says Stewart.
