

A little bit about AARON:

- Aaron is a happy, smart and sweet boy.
- He loves to play with his toy cars and likes to do things that are more independent like riding his bike or playing games on the phone.
- Aaron has limited speech and has services in place that have helped with his communication skills. He relies on facial expressions and body language to determine if someone is being serious or playful. He can also pick up on someone's emotional state. For example, if his caregiver appears to be in distress this can lead to behaviors, since Aaron is affected by the feelings of his caregiver.
- Aaron does well when there is structured, routine, and consistency. He is easily over stimulated when there is chaos or repetitive sounds such as alarms.
- Aaron likes chicken nuggets, fries, pizza, pepperoni, dried cereal, juice, crackers, potatoes and gravy, chicken, pineapple, oatmeal, and spaghetti.

- Mariella is sweet, energetic, and friendly.
- She is a feminine and loves to wear dresses and bows. She plays well with other children and independently. She likes to play with dolls, her kitchen set, and play make-up.
