3. Be willing to participate in media events, panels or speak at trainings.
4. Schedule a speaking engagement for Recruiters at my club, organization, work, church or school.
5. Arrange for a recruitment display or bulletin board at my club, organization, work, church or school.
6. Assist with mass mailings or events by folding, stuffing and preparing materials.
7. Volunteer to oversee a display table for two hours at events, festivals, conferences, expos and fairs.
8. Serve as a recruitment speaker to clubs, organizations, businesses, churches and/or schools a couple of times a year.
9. With the support of a recruiter, host an in-home party for my friends, family, neighbors and co-workers to recruit new families.
10. Volunteer to assist with Recruitment Events such as Foster Parent Appreciation Month, Adoption Month, QPI Recruitment Workgroup, etc.
