

Definitions

Synchronous Instruction



In this type of instruction, learning is happening in real time for students. This includes video conferencing, live webinars, interactive live chat discussions, virtual, and face-to-face instruction.

Asynchronous Instruction



In this type of instruction, learning does not occur at the same time for students. This includes recorded video content and other digital media and content for students to work through independently.

Before Students Arrive

Parents/Guardians and Families are Encouraged to...

- Obtain the schedule for the school and the teacher from the parent.
- Prepare the technology device (Chromebook or other), charger, headphones, login information, and other supplies that are needed.
- Work with the child to practice logging in with the CCSD user name and password.



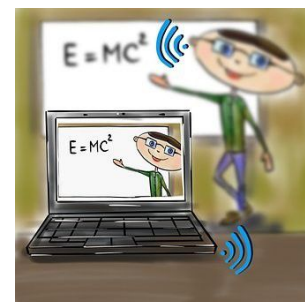
Caregivers are Encouraged to Plan for...

- Obtaining the following information from families during registration:
 - School and teacher schedules
 - Serial numbers to technology device
- Organizing the learning environment for synchronous (live) and asynchronous (independent or recorded) teacher lessons based on each student's schedule.
- Organizing a method for students to store/charge technology devices when not in use.

During Distance Education

Students are Encouraged to...

- Maintain positive attendance and use the learning time effectively.
- Complete all assigned tasks and activities.
- Attend daily and weekly required synchronous (live) and asynchronous (independent/ recorded) sessions.



Caregivers are Encouraged to...

- Communicate with parents/guardians regarding student expectations for distance learning.
- Create and post student schedules.
- Remind students when they should attend synchronous (live) learning and prompt them to remain on task throughout the learning process.
- Assist students with their learning.
