

# CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TRAINING

## 2-Part Training for Foster Caregivers

A Foster Caregiver is REQUIRED to learn the best practices to keep a child riding safely in their vehicle and complete the successful installation of a Child Passenger Safety Seat for a foster child ages 0-6 years old (or 60 pounds).
