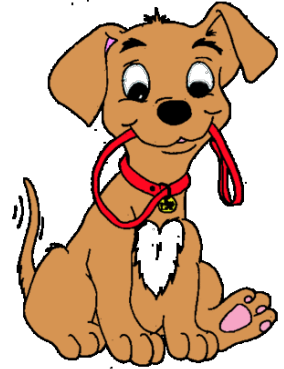


Exhibit Opening: 50 Years of Preserving History
