Contact Your Child's Caseworker if Your Child is Not Attending the School Zoned for Your Home and Your Child May Need Transportation to the School Your Child Your Child is Attending for the 2023-2024

- If your child is attending a school that your home or their placement is not zoned for, your child may need to be signed up for specialized transportation.
- Please contact your child's caseworker if you believe your child needs this transportation as soon as possible to ensure that transportation is provided by the first day of school or as close to the first day of school as possible
- If your child is zoned for the school they are attending, transportation will be set up via the school if needed

CCSD Pre-Kindergarten Programs Accepting Enrollment Requests

- **CCSD Pre-K Programs are accepting enrollment requests for the 2023-2024 School Year. Parents/Caregivers must complete the Pre-K Interest Form by [clicking here](#) to have their child placed on the interest/waitlist.**
- A child must be at least 3 years old prior to August 1, 2023
- Most Pre-K Programs are half day with a limited number of full-day programs.
- Parents/Caregivers must provide transportation to and from school for the child
- **If selected, a child will be offered a Pre-K seat at their zoned school if available. If there is no availability at the zoned school, a child will be offered the closest school with an opening. A child will be placed on a waitlist if there are not available seats at nearby schools.**
- **Parents/Caregivers will be notified via email of their child's placement no later than July 21st, 2023.**
- **Children will be placed into programs throughout the year as they receive applications and have open space.**

Limited Seats Still Available at Select Magnet Schools

- *After the initial lottery process, a select number of Magnet seats remain in CCSD schools/programs for families considering a late application*
- *Magnet Programs offer learning opportunities related to various themes and may have career opportunities in a field of study a child is interested in*
- Transportation is only provided within the geographic boundary of the school but if space is available, a child may be able to get a ride on a bus at the stop closest to the child's home
