COVENANT OF BAPTISM

Presentation of the Candidates by Parents

Parents: We present *NN* to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

Leader: Today, on behalf of these children, you shall make a vows to renounce the devil and all his works, to trust God wholeheartedly, and to serve him faithfully. It is your task to see that this child is taught, as soon as they are able to learn, the meaning of all these vows, and of the Faith that you will profess as revealed in the Holy Scriptures. They must come to put their trust in Jesus, and learn the Creeds, the Lord's Prayer, the Ten Commandments, and all other things that a Christian ought to know, believe, and do for the welfare of their souls. When they have embraced all these, having become a disciple of Jesus, they may come to the Bishop to be confirmed, that they may claim the Faith for their own and be further strengthened by the Holy Spirit to serve Christ and his Kingdom. Are you willing and ready to undertake this?

Parents: I am, the Lord being my helper.

Leader: Do you renounce the Devil and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Parents: I renounce them.

Leader: Do you renounce the empty promises and deadly deceits of this world which corrupt and

destroy the creatures of God?

Parents: I renounce them.

Leader: Do you renounce the sinful desires of the flesh that draw you from the love of God?

Parents: I renounce them.

Leader: Almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness and evil, and lead you into the light and

obedience of the kingdom of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

Leader: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and confess him as your Lord and Savior?

Parents: I do.

Leader: Do you joyfully receive the Christian Faith, as revealed in the Holy Scriptures of the Old and

New Testaments?

Parents: I do.

Leader: Will you obediently keep God's holy will and commandments, and walk in them all the days of

your life?

Parents: I will, the Lord being my helper.

Leader: Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support these children in their life in

Christ?

People: We will.

Leader: Let us join with these candidates to proclaim our faith in the words of the ancient baptismal

confession, the Apostles' Creed.

Leader: Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

People: I do. I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Leader: Do you believe and trust in Jesus Christ?

People: I do. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord; He was conceived by the Holy

Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried: He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge

the living and the dead.

Leader: Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit?

People: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* Church, the communion of saints, the

forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

* The phrase "holy catholic Church" refers to the Church worldwide.

PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

Leader: Let us now pray for these candidate who are to receive the Sacrament of Baptism. Deliver them,

O Lord, from the way of sin and death.

People: Open their hearts to your grace and truth.

Leader: Fill them with your holy and life-giving Spirit.

People: Keep them in the faith and communion of your holy Church.

Leader: Teach them to love others in the power of the Spirit.

People: Send them into the world in witness to your love.

Leader: Bring them to the fullness of your peace and glory.

People: Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader: Grant, O Lord, that all who are baptized into the death of Jesus Christ your Son may live in the

power of his resurrection and look for him to come again in glory; who lives and reigns with you

now and forever. Amen.
