### **The Upside Down: Sermon on the Mount**

*Fulfilling the Law*

## THE NICENE CREED (said together)

**We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made.**

**For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one holy catholic\* and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.**

\*The phrase "holy catholic Church" means the Church worldwide.

## PRAYERS OF GOD'S PEOPLE

**Leader:** *Gracious Father, hear us as we ask, seek and knock at the door of your presence in prayer. Heavenly Father, lead your Church to true humility, knowing everything we have comes from you.*

**People:** **Use our lives to point to your truth and your glory.**

**Leader:** *Lord God, comfort and help us where we have harmed our relationship with you, with others and with ourselves.*

**People:** **Bring comfort also to those who have lost loved ones, those seeking jobs, those who have lost health, and those who need hope. Provide for them and tend to their needs.**

*(You are invited to add your own intercessions, silently or aloud.)*

**Leader:** *Father Almighty, teach us to pray for your Kingdom to come and your will to be done.*

**People:** **Correct us when we stray and forgive us when we fail.**

**Leader:** *Sovereign Lord, we pray for our leaders: For our president and congress, for our governor and state officials, for our mayor and city leaders, and for leaders of the nations throughout the world.*

**People:** **Bring them to saving faith in you, and lead them to govern wisely, judge fairly, and enact policies in keeping with your laws.**

**Leader:** *Merciful Lord, strengthen your people around the world to courageously proclaim your*

**People:** *gospel where doing so will cost them their safety, or even their lives.*

**Shield them and encourage them with your presence; all this we ask in the name of Jesus. Amen.**

## CONFSSION OF SIN (said together)

**Compassionate God, merciful Father, we are poor in spirit and come to you in meekness. We confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.** —*The absolution of sin is to be pronounced by a priest who symbolically stands in the authority of God to forgive the sins of those who truly repent (Matt 16:19, John 20:23).*

**Leader:** *Almighty God have mercy on you, forgive you all your sins through our Lord Jesus Christ, strengthen you in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep you in eternal life. Amen.*

**Leader:** *The peace of the Lord be always with you;*

**People:** **And also with you.**
