



## **FAQs About the Asynchronous Class Format**

What is the asynchronous class format and how does it work?

### **Asynchronous Class Format Defined**

**ALL SUMMER 2021 CLASSES WILL BE ASYNCHRONOUS**

- There are **NO** required live classes at a set day/time.

#### **INSTEAD...**

- Within **CANVAS**, weekly course content will be posted in class modules for students to access at their convenience.
- Within **CANVAS**, weekly discussion board questions will enable students to engage with each other and the instructor.
- Within **CANVAS**, the instructor will post weekly feedback with students.
- Each instructor may choose to offer additional teaching methods beyond the requirements above. Additional methods, including live class meetings, are **OPTIONAL**, but not required.
- **Class Time Conflicts** will **NOT** apply when registering as there is no requirement for **ASYNCHRONOUS CLASSES** to meet live. Thus, even if an instructor chooses to optionally offer live class meetings, time conflicts will **NOT** apply.
- Click on “**Details**” in the online class schedule to check if the instructor will be offering optional live meetings for a class in addition to Canvas course content.
