



FAQs About Emeritus Institute Classes

- **Who can apply and enroll in Emeritus Classes?**
Any adult who is a California resident may take Emeritus Classes.
- **How much do Emeritus Classes cost?**
Emeritus Institute classes are zero-unit, non-credit courses and are tuition-free. When classes meet in-person, some classes (such as art courses) have a small materials fee..
- **Where and when are the classes held?**
As of 2020-2021, classes are being held exclusively online due to COVID-19 restrictions via the Canvas learning system. Traditionally, classes have met at partnering teaching sites throughout our communities, such as senior living communities, community centers, churches, etc. Classes are scheduled on days and times per the Emeritus Institute Class Schedule available on our website.
- **Are Emeritus Classes academic?**
Yes! Our faculty are highly-educated and trained instructors, many of whom teach at other colleges and universities, as well.
- **Do Emeritus Classes have credit value?**
No. Although our classes are academic courses approved by the State of California, they are non-credit.
- **How are Emeritus classes affected by COVID-19?**
Emeritus Institute classes are currently being held exclusively online via the Canvas Learning System due to COVID-19 restrictions. We look forward to our classes returning to our partnering teaching sites when it is safe to do so.
