

GUIDELINES

Outside Events at the Church

1. No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID-19, or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14 days, is permitted on church grounds.
2. All events must be scheduled with the Church Administrator (Missy France) and added to the church calendar.
 - A. Only one outside event will be scheduled each day.
3. Participants must be at least 6 feet apart at all times and at least 10 feet apart if singing or engaged in any athletic activity (this is particularly important when participants are entering and leaving the meeting space as we tend to get closer to each other – this is a new protocol and we all need to be mindful/diligent).
4. Attendance must be taken and recorded for every event.
5. Picnic tables may be used. The meeting organizer must clean the table before and after use. (Note: The church is not cleaning outside)
6. The outdoor worship area may be used.
7. Face coverings over their mouth and nose are highly recommended.
8. If participants bring chairs, it is recommended that they sit in their own chairs and are able to move/setup their own chair.
9. No materials are passed to or between any participant – everyone brings their own paper and materials.
10. No sharing of food or drink – participants may bring their own.
11. Time events to minimize need to go inside the building and use the bathroom. If use of the bathroom is required, only one person should be in the room at a time.
12. Do not plan on coming inside the church for restrooms or inclement weather
13. Do establish a person in your team to monitor these guidelines and maintain adherence
