

All-Parish Campout



Friday, July 28 – Sunday, July 30th

The all-parish campout is returning after four years! **Come for both nights, one night, for the hike, and/or for Sunday Eucharist (drive up and join us if you're not camping).**

- The campground is 6 miles west of Bandelier National Monument near Los Alamos, NM.
- This is a tent-only campground with a covered cooking shelter, pit toilets and drinking water.

- Friday: Gather any time after 4 PM, set up tent, play games, and more.
- Join the optional hike on Saturday afternoon, then enjoy a potluck meal on Saturday evening (**bring your own main dish & a side to share**)
- Worship and Holy Eucharist outside on Sunday morning
- Check-in time is 4:00 PM on Friday
- Check-out time is 11:30 AM on Sunday
- All ages are welcome!
- Max attendees: 100
- **Cost is \$5 per person / night – to be collected by Lucy Sinkular at the campground. Any extra that doesn't cover the campground expenses will go in the offering plate.**

Additional Info:

1. There is a lot of shade at the group campground but sometimes people want to bring shade structures as well for cooking or shelter during the hottest part of the day. There are a lot of trees so hammocks can work well also.
2. We can check-in on Friday anytime after 4:00 pm
3. We welcome you to bring your dogs, even if they are not Hammock Trained like her Indy, but please ensure you keep them well under control and that they are friendly pooches.
4. We tend to hangout around the campfire or lanterns in evening talking and playing games at the tables.
5. Fr. Christopher is working on a small booklet of campfire songs and other misc. If you play guitar or something to accompany music, please feel free.
6. People also are encouraged to bring games that we can play outdoors (Corn Hole, Bocce Ball, Badminton etc.) or table games.
7. Often on Saturday we do a group hike or a group goes to the Bandelier National Monument, so please plan accordingly. (Hiking shoes, small backpacks, water bottles, sunscreen, etc.) People do not have to participate in the Saturday hike or trips but all are welcome to. We usually leave for these after breakfast but some who want to get an early start or do a more adventurous hike may leave camp early on Saturday.
8. We've enjoyed the Los Conchas Hike a few times and also gone to Bandelier
9. We normally have a group meal/potluck on Saturday evening at around 5:30ish. People are encouraged to bring something to share with the group if possible. You may want to bring your own protein as I don't know exactly what people are bringing to share. Somehow the potlucks always seem to work out.
10. We generally have worship from 9:30- 10:30 am on Sunday morning and then pack-up and head out at checkout time of 11:30 am.
11. Also friends or family or other member of the parish are welcome to come up for the Saturday Meal at 5:30 ish and also for Saturday activities or for Sunday Worship. Please feel free and joyful to invite others to participate in some way.
