- 1. At the west end of the big bend in Tramway, turn north on Forest Road 333.
- 2. Continue on dirt road Forest Road 333D where the pavement ends 1.9 miles from Tramway. Don't take the hard-right turn on the pavement, which goes to the La Luz trailhead.
- 3. At 2.4 miles from Tramway, you will be at the Piedra Lisa trailhead. Continue straight on the dirt road through a gate marked "Road Closed" and "No Public Access."
- 4. Bear right when you get to Circle Drive.
- 5. After a short distance on Circle Drive, about three miles from Tramway, turn hard right onto Canoncito Road.
- 6. Continue about one-half mile to 44 Canoncito, which is tall and pink with big windows. You will pass two other houses and the abandoned site of a third. Just follow the road to the end...at our house.
- 7. Its best to turn around before you park. Please leave the area adjacent to our garage clear for others to turn around.
