- Purchaser must be 18 years or older to play and must be in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase. Anyone may purchase tickets, however only residents of Windsor and Essex County, including Comber and Tilbury are eligible for the landscaping services outlined in the Grand Prize due to geographic restrictions.
- Tickets will be sold online on the Community Living Essex County website with purchases made with credit card and hard copy tickets mailed directly to buyers.
- Tickets can be purchased for $\$ 25.00$ each or 3 tickets for $\$ 60.00$
- There will be NO substituting of cash for prizes won. e.g., landscaping services exchanged for the cash value of prize.
- Grand Prize specific winnings of landscaping lawn services including grass cutting and trimming/fertilizing is limited to $\mathbf{5 , 0 0 0}$ square feet of lawn.
- The winning tickets will be drawn from all raffle tickets sold for the draw with two draws. The early bird draw will be conducted on Wednesday, May 18, 2022, at 1pm in Essex and the remaining draw will be done on Thursday, June 23, 2022, at 7pm in Essex.
- The winning ticket for the Early Bird draw and remaining draws will be returned to the draw to be eligible for all other prizes.
- The winning tickets holders will be posted on the CLEC website communitylivingessex.org as well as CLEC social media platforms. The winner's names will be published in the Essex Free Press one week after the draw.
- The winners will be contacted directly.
- The winning ticket holders have $\mathbf{6}$ months in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
