These procedures were developed so that USA Archery can comply with requirements set forth by the U.S. Center for SafeSport and the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee. Athlete safety remains of highest importance to USA Archery, and we appreciate your compliance in putting these procedures into effect. Take some time this week to review the procedures and familiarize yourself with them as they will be in effect from this season onward.

Hosting a USA Archery event is a great opportunity to help archers in your community grow and gain competition experience, and to generate revenue for your club.
