Skilled Nursing

Visiting Nurse & Hospice of Litchfield County provides home health care for people in the comfort and privacy of their home. Our skilled nurses help our patients to continue the recovery process at home and will work closely with the patient's physician to develop a personalized care plan. Medical Social Work

The medical social worker acts as an advocate to coordinate community support, and assists patients and families through the emotional and financial issues that can accompany a health crisis.



Advanced Home Health Care

Visiting Nurse & Hospice of Litchfield County provides services in specialized areas, such as wound care, total joint therapy, disease management, mother and child care and nutrition counseling.

Ultrasound, bladder scans, pulse oximetry and anticoagulation monitoring are some of the advanced services patients may receive in their homes.

Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapies

Physical Therapy helps to improve patients' strength, balance and endurance following illness, injury or surgery.

Occupational Therapy can assist patients who need help with daily activities after illness or injury by improving fine motor skills, developing assistive devices for dressing, bathing and cooking; or teaching sequencing techniques to help patients correctly take their medications.

Speech Therapy helps people who may have difficulty with chewing, swallowing or communicating as a result of disorders such as aphasia, dysphasia, and voice control; as well as challenges related to memory loss and dementia.

Home Health Aides

Home health aides help with daily personal care activities such as eating, bathing, dressing and exercising.

Community Care

Our care team reaches into the community with services such as flu vaccination clinics, blood pressure clinics, foot care clinics and bereavement groups.

Hospice Care

The mission of hospice care is to enable people to receive care in the peace and comfort of their own homes with the loving support of their families. The hospice team works hand-in-hand with patients, their families, and their own personal doctors to provide individually tailored skilled care, emotional support, expert pain and symptom management, spiritual support and the expertise of a certified hospice and palliative care physician.
