



HomeAid Northern California announces the addition of 7 projects

1. Shepherd's Gate in Brentwood:

- Phase 1 expansion of shelter to include counseling rooms, daycare addition
- Signature Homes acting as Builder Captain to complete the \$300,000 expansion



2. West Valley Community Services in Cupertino:

- Pantry expansion to provide basic food needs to extremely low income families
- Edenbridge Homes acting as Builder Captain to complete the \$700,000 remodel



3. 4 Tiny Homes Projects in Alameda County:

- New tiny homes at 4 church sites to add 30 tiny homes to house up to 60
- Dahlin Group and Pacific Interwest are updating the plan changes from the original completed 6 tiny home project at First Presbyterian Church.

4. Bay Area Rescue Mission Bridge of Hope in Richmond:

- Women and children's shelter
- Builder Captain Mark Scott Construction to help with this \$3.5 million project
